2009 Summer Workshop on Social Network Analysis June 1-5, 2009

Each summer, the LINKS Center offers a week-long workshop on social network analysis on the U of Kentucky campus. The workshop features multiple sessions, some of which run concurrently. Last year, we offered the following modules:

1-day	Refresher on Graph Theory and Matrix Algebra	Borgatti, DeJordy & Halgin
3-day	Introduction to Social Network Analysis	DeJordy & Halgin
3-day	Advanced Network Analysis	Borgatti
1-day	Network Research on Organizations	Brass, Mehra, Labianca

For the 2009 workshop, we expect to offer the same modules, plus an additional 3-day session on stochastic models (e.g., exponential random graph models). The different sessions provide a mix of concepts, theory, empirical findings, methodology and software training.

The workshop is appropriate for faculty and graduate students, as well as practitioners in management, health and defense fields. Last year we accepted 70 participants, about half of which were PhD students.
